New Member Induction – Robin Bailey inducted Kate Field - Welcome

Guest Speaker – Sgt Cam Crisp - "Break the Cycle " - 35 years in the force  
Cam spoke about PCYC – Police Citizen Youth Club – 54 branches Nationwide – working with youth – all clubs are self funded not government funded  
Cams club has 61 staff members - PCYC program started 6 years ago in the Brisbane area-  
The program Cam spoke about in detail was helping / working with younger people 16 – 25 years of age gain their drivers license – the applicants must have their L Permit, a log book with min of 10 hrs and proof they can drive – this program is not teaching them to drive but helping them achieve their 100 hrs – providing vehicles, mentors to sit beside them as they complete the required hours  
There are currently 35 mentors working with the drivers in Cam's club with many more people interested in helping out  
The difference for these young people when they get their license is huge, including finding a friend / mentor after hours spent together in the vehicle, lots more opportunities for employment, housing, education for them and their families
